See below.) on your electric bill once the solar farm is completed. Businesses, HOAs, and other entities with electric bills can sign up, too. All you need is a recent electric bill or your account number.

With the Oregon Community Solar Program you:

- Don't need to own your home
- Don't need a sunny roof suitable for solar
- Can take your subscription with you to a new home within your utility's service area
- Aren't responsible for repairs and maintenance of the solar array
- Must be a customer of PGE, Pacific Power or Idaho Power
